(d) Rec'd Infilling H.S. Wpg, Pent. Minister.

(2) Missy hearted thru & thru-- man grt sympathies.

(a) Grt Pastor-- visitor-- helpless, needy
Give last dollar

(b) Strong personal worker

(c) Man of prayer- Kept needs of others before Lord

(d) Evangelistic- hundreds saved thru his ministry

(3) June 1925 became Pastor Wesley Ch. Wpg.

Grt missy Ch- now Calvary Temple.

(4) In fall 1925 we organized Bible Col. in Wpg.
I invited him to join Faculty.

(5) Supt. Man. Dist.

(6) In 1936 elected by Gen. Conf. Supt. FAOC- 8 years

(7) Following change of office - Pastor this Ch, Edt.

(a) Grt leader- organizer-- aggressive worker

(b) later org. NWBI-- Principal until Dean
of Theo- John Cook-- Princ..
