¹ ISP (Integrative Seminar with Portfolio) should be done: 1. as close to the end of the degree as possible OR 2. as close to internship as possible. Biblical Communication is done in conjunction with internship. Preaching & Public Speaking (formerly Homiletics) should be taken prior to internship but could be taken in conjunction with internship with permission from the registrar office.

² Students have the option of taking either an Alliance, Anabaptist, Church of God, or Pentecostal Studies concentration within this program This includes **ONE** of the following denominational courses: *Alliance History & Thought* (through Ambrose), *Anabaptist History & Thought*, *Pentecostalism and the Church of God: History, Thought, and Polity*, or *Pentecostalism & The Church in Canada**. The denominational concentration may also include an additional 3 credit denominational studies course, plus a 4-8 month internship at a ministry approved by the denomination.

Courses separated by a “/” indicate that they are offered as alternating courses every other year.

Students will need to register for a course(s) in the Spring/Summer semesters after second year. The number of Spring/Summer courses depends on their course load and the course schedule.

The BA in Entrepreneurial Ministry requires the transfer in of the **Certificate in Entrepreneurship (10 months)** from Edwards School of Business. “Plus” requirements must be met within 5 years of the completion of the Horizon portion of studies.
