**Internship between years 1 and 2:** Students will register for Writing for Academic Success II, in addition to the Internship, during the summer semester between year 1 and 2, or in the Fall semester. ISP will take place in the winter semester of year 2. (Student will register for Preaching & Public Speaking at the end of 1<sup>st</sup> year before Internship begins)

**Internship following year 2:** Students will register for Writing for Academic Success II during year 2, and will take 3 credits of ISP during the summer semester following year 2 in addition to internship. Alternatively, students could register for ISP in the winter during their "plus" portion. (Student will register for Preaching & Public Speaking at the end of 2<sup>nd</sup> year before Internship begins)

Courses separated by a "/" indicate that they are offered as alternating courses every other year.

Students will need to register for a course(s) in the Spring/Summer semesters after second year. The number of Spring/Summer courses depends on their course load and the course schedule.

The BA in Ministry Leadership 2+2 requires the <u>block transfer in of 49 additional credits</u> (approved & completed) from an approved institution. "Plus" requirements must be met within 5 years of the completion of the Horizon portion of studies.
