

## Summer Youth Ministry Coordinator

As a part of the Government of Canada's Canada Summer Jobs program, Parliament Community Church is looking to hire an individual to fill the role of Youth Ministry Coordinator, working with those grades 6-12.

**Term of the contract:** Beginning May 1, 2024 till August 31, 2024. This role is based on the approval the Canada Summer Grant.

**Hours:** 30-40 hours weekly. Must be available to work Friday evenings and Sunday mornings. Rate of Pay: \$16 per hour.

**Reports primarily to:** Mike Engbers, Lead Pastor.

**Candidate Profile:** A young adult between the ages of 18 and 30, who has a desire to receive work experience in the area of youth ministry. This student must have a solid Christian faith and testimony, adhere to the Mennonite Brethren Statement of Faith and operate within the parameters of our protection policy for the Protection of Children and Youth. Additionally, the student must fit the requirements of funding for a Canada Summer Jobs Grant. They would be self-motivated, and have access to their own transportation.

**Job Description:** The Summer Ministry Coordinator would be responsible for the following:

1. Provide ministry support to our youth ministry including organizing events, connecting with youth individually and in group settings, and providing support and supervision during events. A key part will be carrying out the vision and plans of our Youth Director for summer activities.
2. Work alongside the children's summer ministry coordinator to help with various children's ministry activities and/or other church activities based on giftings and skill set as determined the Lead Pastor and/or other PCC staff.
