Master of Arts in Ministry Leadership

This program prepares Christian leaders for church, lay ministry, and other workplace roles by combining graduate-level leadership training, biblical and theological studies, and specialized ministry practicums. In addition to specialized course work, students will work closely with expert leaders in ministry contexts tailored to their specific vocational interests and needs.

Master of Arts in Clinical Pastoral Counselling

This degree will equip ministry leaders to serve as counsellors in a variety of ministry-based settings: local church, chaplaincy, or non-profit organizations. The distinct nature of the program lies in its integration of spiritual formation, biblical and theological study, and counselling courses. This combination of training, as well as the required practicum for the degree, provides a well-rounded preparation for counselling ministry. The program is also designed to help students meet the academic requirements for gaining professional recognition as a member of the *Canadian Counselling and Psychotherapy Association*, the *Canadian Association for Spiritual Care*, and the *Professional Association of Christian Counsellors and Psychotherapists*.*

Master of Divinity

The Master of Divinity degree provides holistic preparation for pastoral or other types of full-time Christian ministry. The program equips students for effective leadership through the provision of biblical and theological knowledge, professional skills, and real-world experience that centres upon congregational life or other relevant ministry settings. In addition to specialized course work, students in this program will have the opportunity to work closely with expert leaders in ministry contexts tailored to their specific vocational interests and needs.

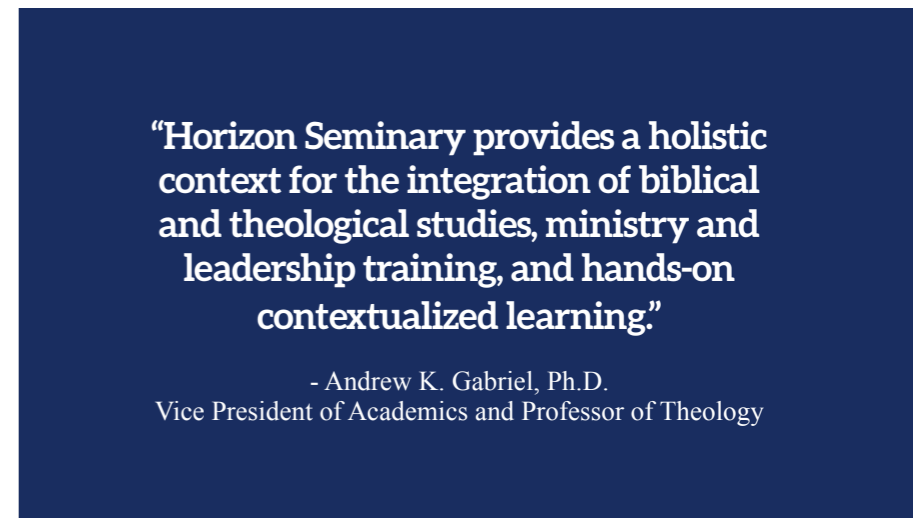


Master of Arts in Biblical & Theological Studies



This degree provides students with the opportunity to deepen their knowledge of the Bible and theology and to grow in their relationship with God. The program equips students with the skills needed to interpret and communicate the scriptures and theological truth effectively in various ministry settings (e.g., teaching and preaching in churches, worship leading, or service in other ministry organizations). Students in this degree will also have the opportunity to hone their skills in a specific area (e.g., biblical languages) or practical ministry (e.g., preaching).
