- **Church Oversight:** Collaborating with church leadership to manage and administer church affairs, steward resources, and implement strategic priorities faithfully and with wisdom, integrity, transparency, and in accordance with Scripture.

- Deep knowledge of Scripture and commitment to its authority; ability to defend the faith.
- Called by God, affirmed by the church.
- Leadership experience in casting vision, guiding a congregation through change, and equipping church leadership, staff, and volunteers for effective and joyful service.
- Strong communication, interpersonal, and relationship-building skills.
- Emotional maturity and self-reflection demonstrated through a healthy self-awareness of emotional patterns, triggers, limitations, and areas for growth together with the maturity to practice appropriate limits and model suitable behaviours.
- Proficient in the use of digital tools and technology for ministry and administration.
- Satisfactory references and background checks.
