¹ Students who already have an advanced undergraduate course in hermeneutics should choose a different elective in any area related to this degree.² Students who have a similar course from their undergraduate degree should choose a different elective in any area related to this degree.³ Pre-requisites: Theological Foundations; Counselling Theory and Techniques.⁴ Pre-requisites: Ethical and Legal Issues in Counselling; Counselling Theory and Techniques.⁵ Pre-requisites: Ethical and Legal Issues in Counselling; Counselling Theory and Techniques; Counselling Skills Lab. Students must complete at least 36 credit hours in their program (12/18 courses) before being eligible to apply for practicum.⁶ Pre-requisites: Ethical and Legal Issues in Counselling; Counselling Theory and Techniques; Counselling Skills Lab; Psychotherapy Practicum I.⁷ Students must complete the Summative Assessment to complete their program and graduate. This requirement will be documented as a Pass/Fail.⁸ Students are strongly encouraged to complete this elective.
