¹ ISP (Integrative Seminar with Portfolio) should be done: 1. as close to the end of the degree as possible OR 2. as close to internship as possible. Biblical Communication is done in conjunction with internship. Preaching & Public Speaking (formerly Homiletics) should be taken prior to internship but could be taken in conjunction with internship with permission from the registrar office.

² Students have the option of taking either an Alliance, Anabaptist, Church of God, or Pentecostal Studies concentration within this program This includes **ONE** of the following denominational courses: *Alliance History & Thought* (through Ambrose), G312/T312 *Anabaptist History & Thought*, G313 *Pentecostalism and the Church of God: History, Thought, and Polity*, or G310 *Pentecostalism & The Church in Canada**. The denominational concentration may also include an additional 3 credit denominational studies course, plus a 4-8 month internship at a ministry approved by the denomination.

G310 *Pentecostalism & the Church in Canada* and T311 *Holy Spirit & the Church* are required courses for PAOC credentials.

³ **Poetry, Wisdom, Apoc Course Options:** Courses such as B430 Psalms, B464 Revelation, B423 OT Wisdom Lit; **Epistles Course Options:** Courses such as B364 Studies in Paul's Letters, B462 Romans.

Courses separated by a "/" indicate that they are offered as alternating courses every other year.

Students will need to register for a course(s) in the Spring semesters after second year. The number of Spring courses depends on their course load and the course schedule.

The BA in Youth Ministry requires an *additional* (approved) **1 Year Child and Youth Care Worker Certificate (30 credits)** from Saskatchewan Polytechnic (or equivalent from an approved institution), ideally your 4th year. "Plus" requirements must be met within 5 years of the completion of the Horizon portion of studies.
