<sup>1</sup> Students have the option of taking either an Alliance, Anabaptist, Church of God, or Pentecostal Studies concentration within this program. This includes **ONE** of the following denominational courses: *Alliance History & Thought* (through Ambrose), G312/T312 *Anabaptist History & Thought*, G313 *Pentecostalism and the Church of God: History, Thought, and Polity*, or G310 *Pentecostalism & The Church in Canada*<sup>\*</sup>. The denominational concentration may also include an additional 3 credit denominational studies course, plus a 4-8 month internship at a ministry approved by the denomination.

G310 *Pentecostalism & the Church in Canada* and T311 *Holy Spirit & the Church* are required courses for PAOC credentials. Courses separated by a "/" indicate that they are offered as alternating courses every other year.

Students will need to register for a course(s) in the Spring semesters after second year. The number of Spring courses depends on their course load and the course schedule.
