Textbooks on the DTL are available to **access** (not order or purchase), similar to borrowing a library book. Contact the library if you have difficulty finding or accessing content.

Please note that students will not have access to the DTL upon graduation. Therefore, we encourage students to purchase select textbooks to build their personal library.

2. Purchase

Students may also choose to purchase books. This is a good option for building a personal library, **obtaining books not available on the DTL**, or for students who prefer to read books in hard copy. When purchasing books, please place your orders as soon as you receive this list in order to receive your order well in advance of your class start date.
