About the Role

Avonhurst Pentecostal Assembly is seeking a part-time **Children's Ministry Director** whose primary responsibility will be to lead, develop, and oversee discipleship-centred spiritual growth for children (typically birth through Grade 5), creating engaging, safe environments for them to encounter, know, and grow in their pursuit of Jesus.

The Children's Ministry Director will work under the direct oversight and supervision of the Student Ministries Pastor until December 31, 2026. This will allow for a healthy and proper handoff of ministry responsibilities, as well as thorough training for the Children's Ministry Director.

Primary Responsibilities

- The running of Sunday morning Children's Ministries at Avonhurst Church, including Children's Church and Nursery
- The scheduling of all volunteers for Children's Church and Nursery, with an aim to have all positions filled a minimum of one month in advance
- The selection and implementation of ministry curriculum, including distributing said curriculum to volunteer leaders and teachers in time for them to properly prepare for Sunday
- The training and recruitment of children's ministry volunteers
- The purchasing and distributing of materials needed for Sunday children's ministries to run properly
- The managing of the children's ministry budget in conjunction with, and under oversight from, the Student Ministries Pastor
- Attendance at weekly Avonhurst staff meetings
- The maintaining of church policies regarding vulnerable sector safety and the implementation of Plan to Protect standards
- Assisting the Student Ministries Pastor in the planning and implementation of a Children's Christmas Program for Sunday morning presentation

Future Development

While this role is currently part-time and contracted on a yearly basis — making it an ideal fit for a Bible college or ministry student — our long-term goal is to see this position grow into a pastoral role with increased hours. As such, there is meaningful room for advancement based on team fit and performance, as well as monetary and resource availability.
