¹ Students have the option of taking either an Alliance, Anabaptist, Church of God, or Pentecostal Studies concentration within this program. This includes **ONE** of the following denominational courses: *Alliance History & Thought* (through Ambrose), G312/T312 *Anabaptist History & Thought*, G313 *Pentecostalism and the Church of God: History, Thought, and Polity*, or G310 *Pentecostalism & The Church in Canada*^{*}. The denominational concentration may also include an additional 3 credit denominational studies course, plus a 4-8 month internship at a ministry approved by the denomination.

G310 *Pentecostalism & the Church in Canada* and T311 *Holy Spirit & the Church* are required courses for PAOC credentials.

Courses separated by a "/" indicate that they are offered as alternating courses every other year.

Students may need to register for a course(s) in the Spring semester after second year. The number of Spring courses depends on their course load and the course schedule.

The BA in Youth Ministry (Coalition 2+2) requires the **block transfer in of 60 additional credits** from The Coalition: Youth Ministry Leadership program. The Coalition: Youth Ministry Leadership credits must be completed either before a student begins the HCS program, or within 5 years of the completion of the Horizon portion of studies.

- The Coalition: Youth Ministry Leadership program is a two-year program consisting of 8 courses, 4 modules, and a 3,000 hour internship.
- Students who complete ***The Coalition: Youth Ministry Leadership*** program **BEFORE** attending Horizon may receive Advanced Standing (without credit) for the following courses:
 - Personal & Christian Life Management / Substitute a General Studies elective
 - Worldviews & Contemporary Culture / Substitute a General Studies elective
 - Intro to Spiritual Formation / Substitute an Open elective
 - Intro to Pastoral Life and Leadership / Substitute an Open elective
