Students must complete at least 33 credit hours in their program (12/18 courses) before being eligible to apply for practicum.⁶ Prerequisites: Ethical and Legal Issues in Counselling; Counselling Theory and Techniques; Counselling Skills Lab; Counselling Practicum I⁷ Students must complete the Summative Assessment to complete their program and graduate. This requirement will be documented as a Pass/Fail.
