Students must complete at least 36 credit hours in their program (12/18 courses) before being eligible to apply for practicum.<sup>6</sup> Prerequisites: Ethical and Legal Issues in Counselling; Counselling Theory and Techniques; Counselling Skills Lab; Counselling Practicum I<sup>7</sup> Students must complete the Summative Assessment to complete their program and graduate. This requirement will be documented as a Pass/Fail.<sup>8</sup> Students are strongly encouraged to complete this elective.
